Manali- Spiti Motorbike Expedition- 6 Days

Season	June to Oct.
Destination	Manali- Spiti
Duration	6 Days

Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Manali - checking and riding your bike

Arrive Manali & check in at hotel. Later, a short briefing on the Motorcycle Tour will be there. A small rundown of road safety precautions and check of personal equipment, we will start out on the narrow adjacent road of villages into the mountains. This is your chance to get acquainted with your bike and get to know the roads. In evening we get back to hotel to have dinner and rest and relax.

Day 02: Manali to Lossar, 145 kms

Today early morning we start our ride from Manali. We cross two high altitude passes: Rohtang (4200m) & Kunzum Pass (4590 meters) to reach Lossar.

Till Rohtang we get tar road but once we cross Rohtang, it is all gravel throughout the bank of River Chandra on whose name the valley got its name "Chandra Valley".

By evening we reach Lossar, we stay in a family house (Homestay) for the night

Day 03: Lossar to Kaza, 6-7 hrs

On this day you will get a glimpse of the culture of Spiti valley. We first ride to Kaza, then ride to Langza, Hikkim Komic Village & the famous Dhankar monastery.

Dhankar the ancient capital of Spiti king is the most incredibly situated gompa, perched high on the barren rocky mountain slopes.

Night stay will be at Kaza.

Day 04: Kaza to Chandertal

Today after breakfast, we'll leave for Chandertal Lake.

Chandra Tal is situated at an altitude of about 4,300 metres (14,100 ft.) in the Himalayas. Mountains of scree overlook the lake on one side, and a magnificent cirque presents a view on the other. Overnight stay at Camp.

Day 05: Chandertal to Manali - 130 km. 8/9 hrs

After breakfast uphill ride to Manali via Rohtang pass, which offers extensive view of the C.B. mount range. Drive through Chandra valley over Rohtang pass (4050 m.) the gateway between Lahaul/Spiti and Kullu "valley of the God" Descending by the snake-curved road through the pasture of wild flowers and

forest of silver Oak, Fir, Popular and waterfalls will accompany till Manali, overnight stay at hotel in Old Manali.

Day 06: Manali Drop

Today after Breakfast drop at Manali bus stand.

What to bring on Expedition

- Riding Gear (Jacket, trouser, gloves, shoes)
- Helmet
- Knee protection
- Waist belt
- Riding gloves
- A snood or (Dust Mask) for keeping dust and cold out of your nose. Sunglasses or bike glasses are essential
- Sun hat is essential
- Thick warm as well as light socks
- Travel towel
- Kidney-belt can be helpful support for the long hours of riding
- A fleece is good for under your jacket
- Day Pack to carry a water bottle, rain suit and other stuff you will use during the day
- A money belt or waist pack in which to carry your passport and other valuables
- Very strong bungee cords or cargo nets
- Basic first aid kit: a few plasters and antiseptic cream
- Any regular medication you need
- Spectacles: bring spares, or your prescription with you
