Itinerary:

Day 01: Arrive at Chandigarh- Shimla (120 Kms / 3-4 Hrs)

Arrive at Chandigarh airport / railway station from where our cab will pick you up and get you transferred to Shimla. You can enjoy the beauty of a historic 17th century Pinjore Gardens on the way. At Shimla, Check-in at the hotel. Enjoy a delicious dinner and spend a relaxed night at the hotel.

Day 02: Shimla City Tour + Kufri (35 Kms / 2-3 Hrs)

Enjoy a tasty breakfast, after that proceed for the local sightseeing of Shimla – the state capital. Visit Advance Study, Jakhu temple and further proceed to cover Kufri – famous for its Himalayan Nature Park, Kufri Fun World, etc. By the evening get back to Shimla town visit Mall Road famous for the Ridge, Lakkar Bazaar, Gaiety Theatre, etc. Facilities for overnight stay and dinner will be arranged at the hotel, in Shimla.

Day 03: Shimla- Manali (250 Kms / 7-8 Hrs)

Day 04: Manali City Tour

Day 05: Manali- Snow Point- Manali

After breakfast, drive to Solang valley and indulge in adventurous activities like parachuting, paragliding or zorbing etc. Return to the hotel in Manali, where dinner and overnight stay facilities are arranged. Rohtang Pass will be depending on climatic conditions & direct payment basis.

Day 06: Manali- Chandigarh (306 Kms / 8-9 Hrs)
