# Manali-Spiti Tour- 7 Days

Exploration of Spiti valley which is a cold desert mountain valley located high in the Himalayas in the north-eastern part of the northern Indian state of Himachal Pradesh is full of raw adventure and thrill. The valley is enclosed between lofty ranges, with the Spiti river rushing out of a gorge in the southeast to meet the Sutlej River.

### **Skeleton Itinerary**

Day 1- Arrive Manali (2050 meters)

Day 2: Manali – Lossar (4200 meters) 145km/ 5-6hrs)

Day 3: Lossar - Kaza Ride for 6-7hrs

Day 4: Kaza(3627meters) – Dhankar & Tabo (6-7hrs)

Day 5: Kaza- Key / Kibber to Chandartal

Day 6: Chandartal- Manali

Day 7: Manali - Bus Stand drop.

### **Itinerary**

### Day 01: - Arrive Manali (2050 meters)

On Arrival pick up from bus stand and transfer to hotel. In afternoon, local sightseeing – Manu Temple, Old Manali, Hadimba Temple, Tibetan Monastery and Market. Evening back to hotel.

#### Day 2: Manali - Lossar (4200 meters) 145km/ 5-6hrs)

Today early morning we start our journey from Manali. We cross, two high altitude passes: Rohtang (4200 meters) & Kunzum Pass (4590 meters) to reach Lossar. Till Rohtang we get tar road but once we cross Rohtang its all gravel throughout the bank of River Chandra on whose name the valley got its name "Chandra Valley". By evening we reach Lossar and stay in a family house (Homestay) for the night.

#### Day 3: Lossar – Kaza Ride for 6-7hrs

On this day you will get a glimpse of the culture of Spiti valley. We first ride to Kaza, then drive to Langza, Hikkim & Komic Village. Back to Kaza.

## Day 4: Kaza(3627meters) - Dhankar & Tabo (6-7hrs)

Today is a complete day to visit Tabo Monastery and Dhankar. Further we drive to Kaza for the night.

## Day 5: Kaza- Key / Kibber to Chandartal

Today we ride to Key first and Kibber village and continue to Kunzum and then will take a turn to Chandartal. In evening, we visit Chandartal Lake and stay at the camps at Chandartal for the night.

# Day 6: Chandartal- Manali

Today drive all the way back to Rohtang pass and Manali. We reach Manali late in the noon or evening.

## Day 7: Manali - Bus Stand drop

After breakfast free visit, afternoon check out from hotel and evening drop at bus stand.
