Skeleton Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Leh – Post lunch Leh city tour Day 2: Leh – Sham Region – Leh (124 kms/ 5-6 Hrs) Day 3: Leh – Nubra Valley (120 kms/ 4-5 Hrs) Day 4: Nubra Valley – Leh (120 kms/ 4-5 Hrs) Day 5: Leh – Pangong Lake – Leh (280 kms/ 10-11 Hrs) Day 6: Depart from Leh

Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival at Leh – post lunch Leh city tour

Arrival at Leh airport, to be received by our representative and transferred to the Hotel. Check in to the hotel for a complete day of rest wherein welcome tea and coffee will be served by the Hotel. Post lunch, visit Leh Market, Leh Palace and Shanti Stupa. Overnight at Leh.

Day 2: Leh – Sham Region – Leh (124 kms/ 5-6 Hrs)











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After breakfast drive for full day sightseeing to the <u>Alchi Monastery</u>, Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, Hall of Fame museum and Sangam (Confluence of Zanskar & Indus River). Back to Leh by evening for your overnight stay.

Day 3: Leh – Nubra Valley (120 kms/ 4-5 Hrs)

After Breakfast drive to <u>Nubra Valley</u> via Khardungla (Highest Motorable road in the World, 18,380 ft.). Arrive at Hunder by afternoon. Lunch at Camp. Rest of the day is free to explore Diskit, Hunder Villages and <u>camel Safari</u> in Sand Dunes between Diskit and Hunder Village. Overnight at Nubra Valley.

Day 4: Nubra Valley – Leh (120 kms/ 4-5 Hrs)

After Breakfast visit Diskit Monastery, where you can have a magnificent view of Nubra Valley and drive back to Leh by same Route, crossing Khardungla Pass. Overnight at Leh.

Day 5: Leh – Pangong Lake – Leh (280 kms/ 10-11 Hrs)

After early Breakfast leave for Pangong Lake (14,500 ft.) through Changla Pass 17,350 ft., it is the third highest motorable road in the world. Arrive Pangong, the highest salt water Lake in the World, shared by two countries India & China. Packed or Hot Lunch will be provided. Enjoy the beauty of the lake on the banks of Pangong while appreciating the changing colors and fascinating high altitude of the Lake. Drive back to Leh by the same route. Overnight at Leh.

Day 6: Depart from Leh

After breakfast get transferred to Leh airport to board flight back to destination. Journey ends with sweet memories of Ladakh.
